



Calling All Appellate Lawyers NOW is the Time to Act. Get Certified!

Register today to take the examination to become a certified appellate specialist at www.californiaspecialist.org. Choose either the Appellate—Civil or Appellate—Criminal examination. The State Bar Board of Legal Specialization offers the written exam biannually and the next one is set for Tuesday, October 25, 2011. You won't have another opportunity to take the exam before 2013.

After passing the examination, you will have eighteen months to document compliance with the experience, education and reference requirements, including: demonstrating that over a five-year period, you spent at least 25% of your practice on appellate work; meeting specific task and experience requirements regarding briefing, oral argument or service as an appellate justice or research attorney; (4) completing educational programs focused on appeals; and (5) identifying five attorneys and/or judges who can vouch for your expertise in appellate law.

Get Certified:

- For your existing and potential clients. Certification as an appellate specialist distinguishes you from the pack and informs existing and prospective clients that you have the experience, knowledge, and reputation necessary to effectively handle cases in the appellate courts. Your status as a certified specialist will appear on your State Bar profile and other Bar resources and you will be able to declare your specialized status in professional profiles, advertisements, press releases, and business cards.
- For your colleagues. Certification tells your colleagues that you are recognized in your field and that you are a resource and can successfully take a case to the appellate level, as well as work at trial to develop and preserve the record.
- For yourself. Pursuing certification will hone and improve your appellate skills. Obtaining certification may help you retain clients and attract new ones so that you can continue to do the kind of satisfying work that you enjoy. And courts have recognized that certification may justify higher rates for your appellate work.
