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**CRITERIA:** The WLS Foundation and ABAS Law Foundation are seeking grant proposals for specific projects related to one of the following needs in our community:

1. safe havens for women and children who may be (a) survivors of persecution based on immigration status, ethnicity, race, sexual orientation, gender, or housing insecurity; (b) survivors of domestic violence or human trafficking; or (c) refugees from regions affected by war or climate disasters;
  2. empowerment of women leaders who have demonstrated a commitment to educational and charitable works in the greater Sacramento region's API community and other underserved communities; or
  3. providing accurate and timely advice about how the law affects underserved and vulnerable populations, including multilingual know-your-rights and access-to-justice resources.
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1. Please provide the **name of your organization** and state **whether your organization is tax exempt**. If so, please identify the applicable section of the Internal Revenue Code.
2. Provide us with the **name of a contact person** within your organization and his or her **contact information**.
3. Describe your **organization's mission** and its activities in the Sacramento community relative to one or more of the three criteria described above. Alternatively, your organization may submit published materials in lieu of preparing a description of your organization's mission and its activities.

- b) Describe the **goals** your project or activity will achieve.
- c) Describe how your proposed activities will achieve your goals.
- d) Provide a **budget** or short summary of how you plan to use the grant funds.
